Linda Carpenter of Richmondville is running for re-election Julie Santoro of Seward During the COVID-19 pandemic shutdown the Library took the opportunity to make building improvements and address the needs of reopening safely. The lighting in the building was changed to LED to reduce our electrical costs. The Children's room was moved to the Becker Room to offer a more welcoming atmosphere. The NY State Construction Aid accessibility project to replace the ramp and improve the lighting and offer a new bike rack was completed in September. We also took the opportunity to adjust the hours of operation.

2020 BY THE NUMBERS

Our collection includes over 36,000 items including print, audio, and eBooks, magazines, newspapers, movies and music.

The building was physically closed for 6 months due to the pandemic and the construction project significantly reducing the number of visitors. However, curbside service was established and over 23,000 items were borrowed or otherwise accessed. Patrons also borrowed 3,800 books and materials through Inter-Library Loan and we sent nearly 3,100 items to patrons at other libraries.

During the past year, the Library provided access to computers and online resources for over 9,000 sessions. 799 people attended the Library's 87 hybrid programs for children, teens and adults. The Library's 33 hybrid summer reading programs involved 409 children and teens.

Prior to shutting down for the pandemic some 12 different community organizations and individuals held 41 meetings at the Library.

YOUR LIBRARY

The Community Library is a member of the Mohawk Valley Library System (MVLS). Along with the Southern Adirondack Library System, MVLS is part of a large network providing library resources to every person in the Cobleskill-Richmondville Central School District. Inter-Library Loan is available to all borrowers and can be done from home or at the Library. Books, movies, music and more can be ordered from any of the 57 libraries in the 8 counties served.

During Library hours patrons may use the public internet-connected computers, stand-alone educational computers, fax machine and copier. New Chromebooks are available to borrow. The Wi-Fi services is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week on Library property.

With your Library card you have access to downloadable books, audiobooks and over 3,000 magazines through the Libby app. We are now connected with CRSD SORA cards.
