VOTING MATTERS Library's 2023 Budget & 2022 Trustee Election Tuesday, May 17, 2022 from 9am to 9pm at the C-R High School

The Community Library operates on a very modest budget. The proposed budget for 2023 is for \$329,769, over 15% of which is covered by state aid, grants, donations, and the fundraising activities of The Friends of the Library. The remainder is funded by taxes approved annually by voters in the Cobleskill-Richmondville School District. Your membership in the Friends is an important way to help our library, but encouraging your friends, family members, and coworkers to turn out to vote in favor of the library's 2023 budget on May 17 is another.

2021 marked 100 years of service for The Community Library. The pandemic forced a postponement of our Roaring '20s afternoon Tea Celebration to April 2, 2022 from 2pm – 4pm. The event is open to the public.

The Community Library Board of Trustees

The Community Library's mission is to build "strong communities by preserving the past, enriching the present, and inspiring the future." The elevenmember Board of Trustees strive to attain these goals by setting policies, overseeing the general operation of the Library, initiating and processing the budget, and hiring and evaluating the director. The Trustees take their responsibility seriously to serve the community by ensuring access to resources and programs that enhance the quality of life of our residents. This important public service role affects every tax payer, whether that person uses the Library or not.

Monthly meetings are open to the public and held on the second Thursday of the month at 1:00 pm and run about two hours. Trustees are expected to attend and participate in two of the six subcommittees that meet on a regular basis for about an hour.

Interested Candidates

Nominating petition forms are available at the Library or the Cobleskill-Richmondville District Office. Petitions need at least 25 signatures of voters living in the School District. Petitions must be filed with the District Office by 5pm on Monday, April 18th. The May ballot will include one four- year term and two five-year terms held by incumbents Janet Sand and Fred Barnes.

The Annex Renovation

In December of 1996 the Library purchased the Annex for \$1 from the Cobleskill Richmondville School District. Over the years the Annex has remained vacant except for the storage of documents and furniture. The Library replaced the roof when it leaked causing interior damage. More recently vandals have broken windows furthering the need to address restoration. The Library Trustees have been meeting with the community, creating plans and seeking funds for restoration. After discussion with the Village Mayor and the Town Supervisor, the Library met with Lamont Engineering staff Brendon Becker. Last fall, discussions about grants and concepts for the restoration started taking shape.

In the Annex plans the first floor will provide space for teens and children, the media collection and a maker space. The second-floor, accessible after hours, will have a large community room, a mixed-use space and a history room for meetings and programs by and for the community. Annex restoration funding to date: The Community Library has been award NYS Environmental Protection Fund support in the amount of \$500,000 and NYS Empire State Development funds up to \$250,000. The Town of Cobleskill has been awarded \$1,184,000 from the NYS Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act.

While this is a significant amount of money we are unsure that it will get us to full restoration of the Annex but it is anticipated the building will be safe and secure. The Library will continue to seek grants to support the full restoration.
