Tiny Art Show challenge begins: Friday, Mar. 1, 10:00 am Come pick up a 3"x3" canvas at the beginning of the month, create a tiny masterpiece with paint, pencils, charcoal, markers, or crayons, and return it to the library by March 30. Submissions will be displayed in April and library patrons will vote on who wins prizes. Open to kids (ages 5+), teens, and adults.
