## The Library's 2025 Budget & 2024 Trustee Election

will be held Tuesday, May 21, 2024 from 9am to 9pm at the C-R High School

The Community Library is expecting portions if not all of the annex to be open in 2025. As a result, the proposed budget for 2025 is \$475,700. Over 16% of the budget is covered by state aid, grants, donations, and the fundraising activities of The Friends of The Library. The remainder is funded by the tax levy approved annually by voters in the Cobleskill-Richmondville School District. The tax levy request on the ballot this year is \$396,000 for budget year 2025. Your membership in the Friends is an important way to help our library, but encouraging your friends, family members, and coworkers to turn out to vote in favor of the library's 2025 tax levy on May 21 is another.

# Battle of the Books


